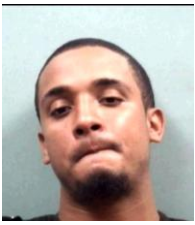
Significant Events

While on regular patrol, officers came in contact with a vehicle which was stopped in the middle of the road. As officers approached the vehicle, ***Stephan Thomas*** was seen throwing a baggie out the window. ***Thomas***



was detained, and subsequently arrested for **Possession of Cocaine, Possession of Paraphernalia, Violation of Community Control, and Driving While License Suspended.**

Carl Strickland was arrested for **Armed Robbery** on March 30th .. The victim reports ***Strickland*** and another person held him at gunpoint while removing all <the victim's> valuable property. ***Strickland*** then left the area, only to be found a few streets away, still in possession of the pilfered items. ***Strickland*** was taken to Cocoa Police Dept for booking on the above charges and later turned over to Brevard County Jail.



Angel Rivera caught the attention of an officer as he sped down a neighborhood street on the evening of March 19th. As the officer attempted to stop him, **Rivera** failed to pull over, passing multiple streets. Eventually, **Rivera's** vehicle stopped in the middle of the road and he was arrested for **Fleeing and Eluding, Driving While License Suspended and No Valid Driver Licence.**

Over **750** foot, vehicle and Segway patrols were conducted in this time frame, of the “hot spots of activity” in our city and over **110** arrests were made. 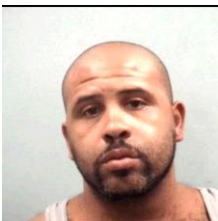

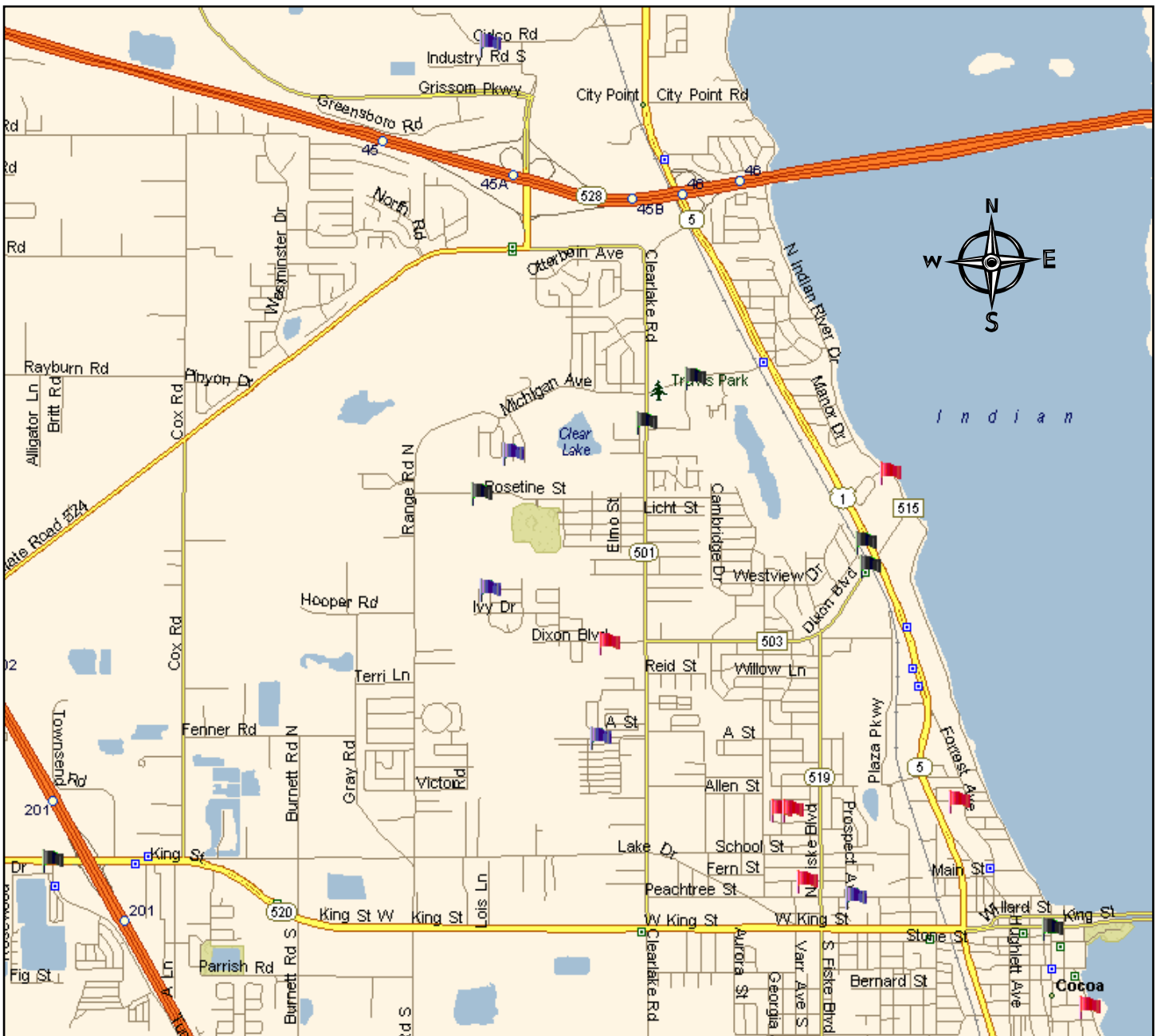

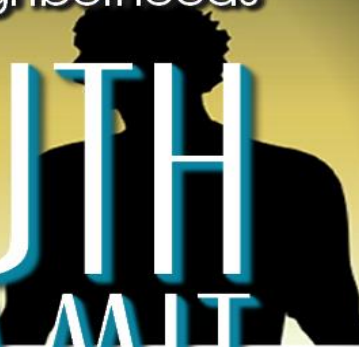
